By challenging the relator's novel reliance on data analytics rather than direct evidence of fraud, the firm secured a dismissal with prejudice, vindicating the client's business practices without the payment of any settlement.

Adam is also a leader in judicial reform. Appointed by the Senate President Pro Tem to the Oklahoma Task Force for the Study of Business Courts, he has played a central role in evaluating and drafting recommendations for specialized courts designed to streamline commercial disputes in the state.
